Winter is now upon us. Oak Hills Local School District uses the One Call Now system to notify families if school is delayed or closed due to weather.

In the event of a closing, no one will be in the building, do not send your child to school.

In the event of a 2-hour delay, school will begin at 10:45am and morning kindergarten (for $\frac{1}{2}$ day students) will be canceled. Students in 1st through 5th grade and KEEP are expected to report to school by 10:45am. Front doors will open at 10:15am.
