EMA Form - Emergency Medical Authorization will let us know what to do in case of a medical emergency with your child. This must be completed each school year. User ID and passwords are being sent home.

The program used by the Oak Hills School District to blast out text and email messages is called One Call Now, or OCN. The program has a limit of 1 contact per student, typically the residential, custodial parent.
