## VI. <u>BOARD DISCUSSION</u>

### A. World Language Elective

Will Beinkemper (Assistant Principal) and Grant Anderson (Assistant Principal) provided a document outlining the history, revisions, and OHLSD next steps regarding Grades 6-12 of World Language. Planning for entry of immersion students into the Middle School will be discussed in the summer.

#### B. K-12 ELA Instructional Review

Amy Brennan (Director), Candice Lessing (Assistant Principal), Kristen Grote (Assistant Principal), and Will Beinkemper (Assistant Principal) provided a document regarding an English Language Arts Instructional Review. The document included Aspirations (Foundational Beliefs Regarding Literacy), Key Components, and current status work/next steps. A schedule for reading instructional review demo lessons will begin on January 23<sup>rd</sup> and conclude on February 21<sup>st</sup>.

#### C. School Fee Discussion

Mr. Bain provided a handout illustrating the history and current student fee amounts; as well as comparative data to other school districts. Mr. Bain thanked the secretarial staff and administrative staff for consistently enforcing the policy. A recommendation of \$25 to instructional fees will be brought before the Board at the February meeting.
