IV. BOARD DISCUSSION

A. Athletic Facility Update

Mr. Hemmelgarn (Athletic Director) and Kyle Prosser (Assistant Athletic Director) provided an update and a handout updating the progress on private athletic funding. Mr. Hemmelgarn and Mr. Prosser are focused on raising funds for a replacement track, school message boards, and a new high school stadium scoreboard. Funds are being raised by requesting support from local business partners, community members, alumni, staff, boosters, and townships. The Athletic Department is also in the process of applying for a grant to re-surface the tennis courts. The Athletic Department plans to administer their website internally. If a loan was needed for private capital projects (such as the track), this loan would be administered by the Boosters.

B. OHHS Presentation - Hope Squad

Travis Hunt (High School Principal), and three sophomores (Sarah Bussard, Mayson Reperowitz, and Emma Sedlack) from OHHS explained the peer to peer Hope Squad Program (a mental health program) to assist students in need. The Hope Squad is currently used by many districts in Utah. The Hope Squad is a program to identify students struggling with emotional and/or mental health concerns. The Hope Squad is in place to reduce and hopefully eliminate student suicide. The Hope Squad may be introduced in the 2018-19 school year. A handout was provided. Lakota and Mason are piloting this program.

C. Career Readiness Update

Mr. Hunt (Principal), Mrs. Brennan (Director), Kristen Grote (High School Assistant Principal) and Brady Faust (Teacher) shared opportunities available at Great Oaks and shared options for students that are interested in careers in lieu of college education programs. The team provided a handout which illustrated paths available for students by grade level. Programs were shared of current offerings at Oak Hills High School and students are invited to visit Great Oaks through a District field trip. Values of the Tartan Time were after school.
