 - One Heart One Hope Committee The One Heart One Hope non-profit organization assists with district families experiencing hardship. The committee raised approximately \$4,000 this year.
 - Oak Hills Athletic Boosters & Oak Hills Athletic Department The annual sports stag occurred in May & generated a record \$39,000.
 - Oak Hills Alumni & Education Foundation Thanks for hosting the recognition dinner in May & congrats to all award winners. OHAEF is privately funding a portion of a Book Bus to assist with student literacy across the district. OHAEF has already raised \$47k.

TREASURER'S REPORT

- Mr. Bain presented:
 - Financial Statements April & May
 - The Senate made amendments to House Bill 110 (biennium budget). The Senate plan removed the Fair School Funding Model, however still directly funds community schools & vouchers, which is beneficial for public school districts. The Senate version did still include a deduction for open enrollment in the proposed formula (OHLSD has 141 students open enrolling to other districts (costing the district nearly \$845k). The Senate plan increases OHLSD funding levels by nearly 3% each fiscal year, whereas the House plan, OHLSD is nearly flat lined, although open enrollment deductions are removed. The Senate is expected to vote on the bill this week & send it to conference committee.

 House Bill 290 (Sponsor Rep. McClain (R) Upper Sindusky) would provide a voucher to any student (this is referred to as the Backpack Bill). OHLSD & public education oppose this two page bill (which hasn't been voted on by the House). West Virginia recently passed similar legislation.

Oak Hills Alumni & Education Foundation - Kim Sims Book Bus

- The OHALL had a retreat and strategic plan which provided the following themes:

- The desire to ensure all students had access to leisure reading was formed and from that, the idea of a book bus was created (similar to Princeton school district). The goals of the bus were:
 - 1. Build joy of reading
