#### **BOARD DISCUSSION**

- A. Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) Academics: Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment
  - Dr. <u>Tim Cybulski</u> (Assistant Superintendent), Corey Kessler (K-8 Curriculum Director) and <u>Bridgette Smiley</u> (9-12 Curriculum Director) led the discussion on the district's core instruction, targeted intervention, intensive interventions, additional resources, and the state report card. MTSS integrates response to intervention and positive behavioral interventions and support into a preventative framework that delivers differentiated support matched to the needs of the whole child. A timeline of the MTSS was shared and also a handout was provided.
- B. Preschool Update
  - Candice Lessing (Associate Director of Student Services) illustrated the continuum of preschool services under the old requirements and new requirements. The state is in the process of implementing new requirements on preschool settings from least restrictive to most restrictive. New requirements would require additional staffing and support. A handout was provided.
