V. BOARD DISCUSSION

- A. Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) Academics: Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment
 - Dr. <u>Tim Cybulski</u> (Assistant Superintendent), Rachel Searcy, Lis Klotz, and Candice Lessing (Student Services Team), along with Bill Murphy (Director of Safety and Security) provided a handout on the MTSS model. The topics of discussion included Positive Behavior Support, Social Emotional Learning, Safety and Security, as well as the future vision for MTSS.

B. Staffing Update

 Dan Beckenhaupt (Director of Human Resources) illustrated the process for staffing levels in our district, which is driven by enrollment, and negotiated agreement language. Ben Hageman (Athletic Director) provided the philosophy and practice on hiring coaches. A handout was provided.

VI. COMMUNICATIONS

• Mrs. Schoonover congratulated Oak Hills Alum Elizabeth Cron on winning the national championship in the 1 meter diving at the Division III championship. Elizabeth attends the University of Chicago.

- Mr. Brandt communicated:
 - The 4th Quarter starts tomorrow.
 - Covid dashboard reporting is no longer required.
 - HB 582 legislation that would limit a board to a 2-year seat, with a 4 term limit.
- Mr. Bain communicated:
 - The STRS Board approved a one-time cost of living adjustment and also changed the requirement to retire at age 60, set to go in effect in 2026. Now, retirees will only need 35 years of service to retire and there is no minimum age requirement.
 - The Southwest Ohio Organization of School Health (SWOOSH) signed a 4 year agreement with MetLife to serve as the district's dental insurance provider (effective Jun 1, 2022). Additional communication to the staff will occur in the upcoming months.
