#### IV. BOARD DISCUSSION

A. Five Year Forecast - Steve Bain and Jamie Behrle(Assistant Treasurer) reviewed the fiscal health of the district. Historically, as well as future projections, indicate sluggish revenue growth (1%) and modest expenditure growth (3%-4%). The district's property taxes and TIF collections are highly volatile, shifting by 25% for fall TIF collections, thus making projections challenging. The district's cash balance (savings account) will significantly decrease upon the expiration of the stimulus funds in 2024. The district (and any public school district) cannot borrow, thus they can only add (levy) and/or reduce (cuts). Levy simulations were illustrated for the Board. A handout was provided.

**B. Report Card Data** - Tim Cybulski (Assistant Superintendent) reported on the district's achievement level including progress components, graduate rates, gap closing, and other measures. Performance by course for the last 3 years was also shared. An in depth review of Advanced Placement courses was reviewed. Principals at all levels shared their Academic Improvement Model (AIM) as well as district and building goals.
