A. Financial Update:

- Mr. Bain presented and communicated:
 - Historical cash balance since 2010
 - Current and projected cash balance per the five year forecast
 - The pending state budget will play a significant factor in the district's future cash balance as state simulations indicate the district would receive a reduction in funding of approximately \$9 million
 - Even if state funding is held harmless, local taxes (and funding formulas) have been an item discussed by legislators for the past 18 months
 - The board and administrative team should have financial goals which will assist in creating a fiscally responsible plan through increased funding or reduced expenditures
 - OHLSD is 1 of 4 districts (out of 23 Hamilton County districts) not to have additional local tax increases since at least 2013

B. SHP Architects Update (Construction Project):

- Jeff Parker and Mike Parkinson (SHP) provided an update on the construction project and provided a PowerPoint
- Items discussed included:
 - Update on community engagements (thus far over 500 community and/or staff members have been engaged in the process)
 - Potential master plans which were crafted by the community
 - The board of education shared plans on the masterplan
 - The tag line "Building Oak Hills" will be used
 - Next steps
