**A. Public Participation at Board Meetings**

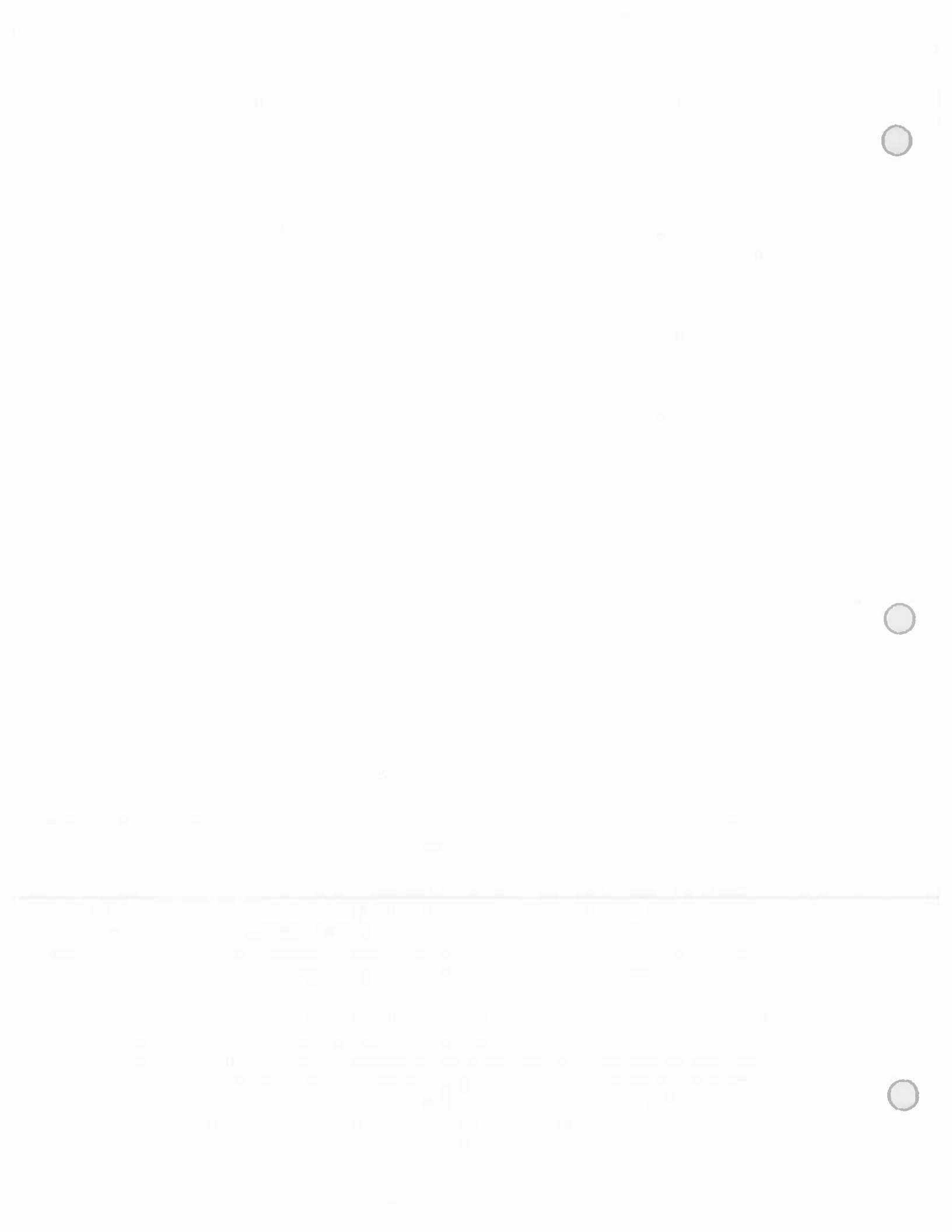
- The board discussed policy 0169.1 Public Participation at Board Meetings.
- The current policy includes two 30 minute sessions on the agenda for public participation (one prior to the board vote and one after the board vote). The board will be revising the policy to one 60 minute public participation session which will occur prior to the board voting on any items on the agenda. The board president will have the discretion to add a section to public participation after the board vote without this being listed on the agenda.

**B. Oak Hills High School Clubs / Extracurriculars**

- Brian Conners (Principal of Oak Hills High School) shared student participation levels in student clubs and extracurriculars. There is a direct correlation between student achievement and involvement in extracurricular activities. Student participation levels continue to increase in clubs, arts, and athletics. **C. College, Career, Workforce, and Military Readiness Update**

- Kristen Listerman (Teacher at Oak Hills High School) presented career readiness and approved pre-apprenticeship pathways. Areas that students are being placed include architecture & construction, information technology, manufacturing, health sciences, hospitality & tourism, law, safety, corrections and security. 
