- 11. Attendance Reminders Parents are responsible for contacting the school absence line (513-922-1485-press "1" for attendance) each day to give the <u>REASON</u> for a child's absence. You can email the teacher as well but please copy the attendance secretary (blome_d@ohlsd.org) on any email so that she can document the reason for each absence. If a parent calls the absence line but does NOT give the reason for an absence or emails the teacher but doesn't email the attendance secretary <u>the</u> absence is unexcused. After 10 days (60 hours) of absences, a student must have a doctor note to excuse an absence. Please remember that all tardy/late arrivals count in the tally for attendance as well. School starts at 9am which means the student must be in the *classroom*, ready to go at 9am!

12. Just a reminder: In order for ANY medication to be given at school a medication form must be brought in every year. This includes any prescription medications, EpiPens, inhalers, seizure medications, and as needed medications. Downloadable medication forms can be found at <u>www.ohlsd.us</u> under the Health Room department.

Reminder: A student may only be released during the school day to someone listed as Legal Guardian or an Emergency Contact on his/her EMA. A photo ID is required to pick up a student.
