9. Just a reminder: In order for ANY medication to be given at school a medication form must be brought in every year. This includes any prescription medications, EpiPens, inhalers, seizure medications, and as needed medications. 10. Attendance Reminders - Parents are responsible for contacting the school absence line (513-922-1485-press "1" for attendance) each day to give the **REASON** for a child's absence. You can email the teacher as well but please copy the attendance secretary (blome\_d@ohlsd.org) on any email so that she can document the reason for each absence. **If a parent calls the absence line but does NOT give the reason for an absence, the absence is unexcused.** Please remember that all tardy/late arrivals count in the tally for attendance as well.
