  - Add Additional Numbers The student's primary contact can create a My Call Now account to add an additional 5 email addresses or cell phone numbers to also receive One Call Now alerts and messages. You may do this by going to <a href="https://www.mycallnow.com">https://www.mycallnow.com</a> and creating an account using the Primary contact's email address and your student's ID number.
  - \* Please note school district personnel are not able to access phone numbers or email addresses entered on this site, only the Primary Contact can make changes to the mycallnow system.

  - Our Transportation Department is hiring bus drivers, bus aides and crossing guards. These positions are very important to the mission of Oak Hills Local Schools and as a part of the Oak Hills team.
  - Bus-driver positions start at \$19.14 per hour with flexible work schedules, summers off and benefits for full- and part-time positions. Through our CDL program, we will pay you while you train and help cover some costs for the CDL license.
  - We are looking for substitute bus aides, with starting pay of \$13.66 per hour, and substitute crossing guards, with starting pay of \$12 per hour.

Please check your email to see if you have an outstanding fee that needs to be paid or if you think you qualified for a fee waiver this year and the fees have not been waived then please contact the office at 513-922-1485. Waivers must be applied in the current school year. Past due years fees cannot be waived.

If you have applied online for free lunch and received approval for the fee waiver or paid your fees via EZ Pay you do not need to send in a form to the office.
