- 11. Just a reminder: In order for ANY medication to be given at school a medication form must be brought in every year. This includes any prescription medications, EpiPens, inhalers, seizure medications, and as needed medications. - 12. Attendance Reminders Parents are responsible for contacting the school absence line (513-922-1485press "1" for attendance) each day to give the **REASON** for a child's absence. You can email the teacher as well but please copy the attendance secretary (blome_d@ohlsd.org) on any email so that she can document the reason for each absence. If a parent calls the absence line but does NOT give the reason for an absence, the absence is unexcused. Please remember that all tardy/late arrivals count in the tally for attendance as well. School starts at 9am which means the student must be in the *classroom, ready to go at 9am*!

Reminder: A student may only be released during the school day to someone listed as Legal Guardian or an Emergency Contact on his/her EMA. A photo ID is required to pick up a student.
