- 9. An Important Reminder from the District Nurse A REMINDER TO PARENTS: Oak Hills Local School District has a policy that a student must be free of a fever (100) and without the use of fever reducing medications for 24 hours BEFORE they can return to school. A student must not vomit for 24 hours BEFORE they can return to school. A student must not vomit for 24 hours and preventing others from getting sick. Please remember to call the school (513-922-1485, press 1 to leave a voice mail on the absence line before 9:45am) to report your student's absence during this time frame.
- 10. Attendance Reminders Parents are responsible for contacting the school absence line (513-922-1485-press "1" for attendance) each day to give the <u>REASON</u> for a child's absence. You can email the teacher as well but please copy the attendance secretary (blome_d@ohlsd.org) on any email so that she can document the reason for each absence. If a parent calls the absence line but does NOT give the reason for an absence or emails the teacher but doesn't email the attendance secretary the absence is unexcused. After 10 days (60 hours) of absences, a student must have a doctor note to excuse an absence. Please remember that all tardy/late arrivals count in the tally for attendance as well. School starts at 9am which means the student must be in the *classroom*, ready to go at 9am!
- 11. Just a reminder: In order for ANY medication to be given at school a medication form must be brought in every year. This includes any prescription medications, EpiPens, inhalers, seizure medications, and as needed medications. Downloadable medication forms can be found at <u>www.ohlsd.us</u> under the Health Room department.

Reminder: A student may only be released during the school day to someone listed as Legal Guardian or an Emergency Contact on his/her EMA. A photo ID is required to pick up a student.
