- 17. An Important Reminder from the District Nurse: Oak Hills Local School District has a policy that a student must be free of a fever (100) and without the use of fever reducing medications for 24 hours BEFORE they can return to school. A student must not vomit for 24 hours BEFORE they can return to school. This policy protects everyone in the building from spreading illnesses and preventing others from getting sick. Parents must still call the school (513-922-1485, press 1 to leave a voice mail on the absence line before 9:45am) to report your student's sick day absence during this time frame.
- 18. Attendance Reminders Parents/Guardians are responsible for contacting the school absence line (513-922-1485-press "1" for attendance) each day to give the <u>REASON</u> for a child's absence. You can email the teacher as well but please copy the attendance secretary (blome_d@ohlsd.org) on any email so that she can document the reason for each absence. If a parent calls the absence line but does <u>NOT</u> give the reason for an absence or emails the teacher but doesn't email the attendance secretary <u>the absence is unexcused</u>. After 10 days (60 hours) of absences, a student must have a doctor note to excuse an absence. Please remember that all tardy/late arrivals count in the tally for attendance as well. Morning Kindergarten starts at 8:50am and Afternoon Kindergarten starts at 12:45pm. School starts at 9am for 1st 5th grades which means the student must be in the *classroom*, ready to go at 9am!
