## Dear Colonel Families,

As we navigate through how to exchange school items both ways (from you to us and us to you), safety remains at the forefront of our discussions. While we know the process will be a bit messy and congested, we will work tirelessly to make sure you get all of your personal belongings from school. Our plan is to have a three hour window per grade level in the last week of school. In that window you would drive through the lot and get your student's belongings from a staff member. While we know some of our families have students in multiple grades, we will only have one grade at a time going due to the volume of students. If you can not make it back for your child's other grade, we will ask you to pull into a spot in the lot and we retrieve the other child's objects from their classroom, and bring it to your car. If you are bringing back items such as library books, instruments, or classroom books we will have designated bins to drop those off as well at the same time. More specific details will come out next week, but we wanted to give you a heads up on the process ahead of time.

Also, we are planning a parade day on Thursday, May 21. We will have staff on campus, safely apart throughout the parking lot and you will be able to drive through with your children and say goodbye from your cars. While we will not allow any items to be passed back and forth during this time, we wanted the opportunity to see our Colonels one last time before we close out the 2019-2020 school year.
