Governor DeWine indicated that Hamilton County will stay in the "orange" range as a county. This means we go five days per week in person with students. We are NO LONGER in a blended learning model. Student enrolled in Virtual Academy will continue to learn at home.

What this means for our families.

- 1. All in person learning students will report to CO Harrison Elementary school five days per week.
- 2. We will continue to enter the building the way we have since the start of this school year.
- 3. Drop off and pick up will be in the same location.
- 4. Students with the last name beginning with the letters A L will be in carpool #1 at 3:15 p.m. The lot will open at 3:00 p.m. and we will begin releasing cars at 3:20 p.m. PARENTS, please be here by 3:15 if you are in carpool #1.
- 5. Students with the last name beginning with the letters M Z will be in carpool #2 at 3:45 p.m. PARENTS- if you are in carpool #2 please do not arrive before 3:30 p.m. We will not open the lot for carpool #2 until then.
- 6. Students that are walking will be dismissed out the catwalk doors at 3:15 p.m. and bus riders will stay in their classroom until the bus is called.
- 7. If your child needs to do something differently please email your child's teacher the day before. We will work with you on dismissal for carpool situations.
- 8. Chromebooks will no longer go home with students each day. Chromebooks will stay in homeroom to charge each night and over the weekend.
- 9. Students will be eating in the classrooms so please pack utensils and napkins too!

The Food Service Department is offering ALL of our virtual academy students breakfast and lunch FREE OF CHARGE through December 31, 2020. We encourage everyone to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity as it provides your child with meals for the week and helps to keep our food service program sustainable. - 1. The deadline for purchasing 20-21 Chromebook Insurance is Wednesday, September 30th, 2020. Chromebook Insurance is \$20 and can be purchased online using EZ Pay on the Parent Portal @ ohlsd.org or mailing a check or money order to the school at 585 Neeb Rd. Cincinnati, OH 45233. If you mail in or send in a payment with your student, please download a copy of the Chromebook Insurance paperwork to fill out and include with your payment. - 2. 20-21 Instructional Fees are \$85 and can be paid online using EZ Pay on the Parent Portal @ ohlsd.org or mailing a check or money order to the school at 585 Neeb Rd. Cincinnati, OH 45233. If you mail in or send in a payment with your student, please download a copy of the Instructional Fee paperwork to fill out and include with your payment. Click here for a link to the Instructional Fee Paperwork.
- 3. Any cash payments sent in with students for Instructional Fees or Chromebook Insurance must include the paperwork, be in an envelope with the student name and it must be for the **EXACT** amount. Teachers do not have change.
- 4. Attendance reminder! Please make sure to report the reason for your child's absence each day they are absent-this includes remote learning days as well as student sick in Virtual Academy. Parents must contact the school @922-1485, press "1" to leave a message on the absence line. Messages must include your student's name, your name, teacher's name and grade level as well as the reason for the absence. You may also email the attendance secretary @ blome d@ohlsd.org to report the reason for your child's absence each day. If you receive a OneCallNow message that a child of yours has been reported absent with no call to the school (or email) then your child will be unexcused. You must contact the attendance secretary to report the reason WHY your child is not in school.
- 5. Primary contacts (Residential Parent/ Legal Guardian) can add up to 5 additional emails or phone numbers to the OneCall Now system by creating an account with mycallnow. Here are the instructions:
 - Add Additional Numbers The student's primary contact can create a *My Call Now* account to add an addition 5 email addresses or cell phone numbers to also receive *One Call Now* alerts and messages. You may do this by going to https://www.mycallnow.com and creating an account using the Primary contact's email address and your student's ID number.
 - * Please note school district personnel are not able to access phone numbers or email addresses entered on this site, only the Primary Contact can make changes to the *mycallnow* system.
