**Friday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021-Remote Learning Day**

1. Make-up Day for Classroom Pictures with Ritchie Photo will be Friday, February 26<sup>th</sup> from 11am-2pm. If your child was absent on February 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> and missed getting a photo taken on green screen for the composite classroom picture then please send in your order form with your child on Friday, February 26<sup>th</sup>.
2. **ATTENTION Parents of Virtual Academy Students:** 41 Virtual Academy student workbooks for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester are still waiting to be picked up in the lobby. We are now in the 4<sup>th</sup> week of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter and these student workbooks are still here at school. Please call 922-1485 to contact Mr. Mr. Conners at the Front Desk to schedule a time to pick up your child's workbook for Virtual Academy
3. Lifetouch Pictures will be here in the Big Gym on Tuesday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 for Spring Pictures! All students will be photographed but make sure to send in your order form on Picture Day so that your picture packet will be printed. **Picture Packets will only be printed for prepaid orders** which can be paid online or on picture day with a completed order form with payment enclosed. Look for Order Forms with payment instructions to come home with students on Friday, February 26<sup>th</sup>. Virtual Academy Students can come to school between 2:30-3pm on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 to be photographed.
4. C.O. Harrison Elementary School's Follett Books Book Fair is going to be ONLINE this year. It is going to be March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 - March 15, 2021. A Follett Books eFair link will be coming out soon. All proceeds will go to buy books for the library.
5. REMINDER about the Flu Season:  
Flu viruses are most common during the fall and winter seasons. Flu is a contagious respiratory illness caused by influenza viruses that infect the nose, throat, and sometimes the lungs. It can cause mild to severe illness. The best way to prevent flu is by getting a flu vaccine each year. The Center for Disease Control recommends that everyone 6 months and older receive a yearly flu vaccine. It is especially important to get a flu vaccine if you have a chronic health disease, over 65 years of age, pregnant or have a weakened immune system due to disease or medication.  
Flu vaccines are available at commercial pharmacies (Walgreens, CVS), health provider offices and at clinics.  
The Hamilton County Health Department has a flu clinic available for children who are uninsured, under insured, or are receiving or eligible for Medicaid. [Click here for information about scheduling an appointment at Hamilton County Health Department](#)
6. Primary contacts (Residential Parent/ Legal Guardian) can add up to 5 additional emails or phone numbers to the OneCall Now system by creating an account with mycallnow. Here are the instructions:

**Add Additional Numbers** - The student's primary contact can create a *My Call Now* account to add an addition 5 email addresses or cell phone numbers to also receive *One Call Now* alerts and messages. You may

do this by going to <https://www.mycallnow.com> and creating an account using the Primary contact's email address and your student's ID number.

\* Please note - school district personnel are not able to access phone numbers or email addresses entered on this site, only the Primary Contact can make changes to the *mycallnow* system.

7. Dear Highlander Families,

We have exciting news to share with our families. As a result of extended federal legislation, all students in all Oak Hills elementary schools and in Delhi Middle School are now eligible to receive **free meals at school every day through May 28, 2021**. There are no family financial requirements for receiving the meals.

At Delhi Middle School, Delshire Elementary, J.F. Dulles Elementary, **C.O. Harrison Elementary** and Oakdale Elementary, students will receive free breakfasts and free lunches. Springmyer Elementary students will receive free lunches since the school does not serve breakfast.

**Students at all schools can continue to purchase a la carte items in addition to their free meal.** Students are welcome to take their breakfast to their classroom so we encourage them to stop by their cafeteria each morning.

**While all students are automatically eligible for the free meals, we encourage families with financial need to still complete the free and reduced lunch application. This is critical as it determines if families qualify for a waiver of instructional fees. The application is available at [www.lunchapplication.com](http://www.lunchapplication.com) and paper applications are available in each school office.**

The new federal program is intended to support families as the nation recovers from the pandemic, and also to provide financial support for school food-service programs that lost revenue during school closures and hybrid model learning days. We are excited to see so many families benefiting from this legislation and hope to continue to see our families through the end of this school year.

8. **Attendance reminder!** Please make sure to report the **reason** for your child's absence each day they are absent-this includes remote learning days as well as students sick in Virtual Academy. Parents must contact the school @922-1485, press "1" to leave a message on the absence line. Messages must include the **reason** for the absence along with your student's name, your name, teacher's name and grade level. You may also email the attendance secretary @ [blome\\_d@ohlsd.org](mailto:blome_d@ohlsd.org) to report the reason for your child's absence each day. If you receive a message from OneCallNow that a child of yours has been reported absent with no call to the school (or email) then your child will be unexcused. **You must contact the attendance secretary to report the reason WHY your child is not in school or else those absences are considered UNEXCUSED ABSENCES.** All out of town absences (vacations, etc.) are unexcused absences per District Policy.

9. 20-21 Instructional Fees are \$85 and can be paid online using EZ Pay on the Parent Portal @ [ohlsd.org](http://ohlsd.org) or mailing a check or money order to the school at 585 Neeb Rd. Cincinnati, OH 45233. If you mail in or send in a payment with your student, please download a copy of the Instructional Fee paperwork to fill out and include with your payment. 10. Any cash payments sent in with students for Instructional Fees must include the paperwork, be in an envelope with the student name and it must be for the **EXACT** amount. Teachers do not have change.
