# SCOLIOSIS SCREENING FOR STUDENTS:

The OHLSD nursing department will be conducting scoliosis screenings starting next week during school hours. Trained nurses will be conducting scoliosis screenings and following the American Academy of Pediatrics recommendations of screening 6th-grade girls only, 7th-grade girls only, and 8th-grade boys only. This screening will detect those students who may have a spinal problem. If you do not want to have your child screened in this fashion or have questions, please contact your child's school nurse.

Schools must receive the most updated vaccine record that includes the 7th grade requirement of booster Tdap and MCV4 as described above. Parents will need to contact their doctor's office to request an updated vaccine record to submit to school. Please call your doctor's office soon to verify that your child has received these booster vaccines. If they have not, please make an appointment for your child to receive these vaccines before the start of next school year. Records can be submitted to school via your child, email or mail. You may also ask the doctor if they can fax the updated record to the school at 964-0284.
