7th Grade Parents

The Ohio Law requires that before entering 7th grade, students must receive the following vaccines: one dose of Tdap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) and one dose of MCV4 (Meningococcal.) Most children will receive these vaccines around 11-13 years of age. Schools must receive the most updated vaccine record that includes the 7th grade requirement of booster Tdap and MCV4 as described above. Parents will need to contact their doctor's office to request an updated vaccine record to submit to school. Please call your doctor's office soon to verify that your child has received these booster vaccines. If they have not, please make an appointment for your child to receive these vaccines

Academic Eligibility for Participation in OH Athletics for Fall Season 2023-24

This is just a quick reminder that our 4th academic quarter will determine Athletic Eligibility for the Fall 2023 Sports season . Please check grades, improve any low grades if possible and/or continue to maintain high expectations and grades!

Each student athlete must be taking and passing at least 4 classes. All classes count including Fitness Education classes.

For current 6th grade, 7th grade and 8th grade students, they must follow the above requirement. Whether the students are current 8th graders moving to Oak Hills, or whether the students are 6th grade students moving to 7th grade athletics. 4th Quarter grades will affect Fall Sports eligibility to play any of the following sports- Football, Boys' and Girls' Golf, Girl's Tennis, Girls' Volleyball, and Cheerleading, and Cross Country.
