September Wellness Calendar

7th Grade Parents

The Ohio Law requires that before entering 7th grade, students must receive the following vaccines: one dose of Tdap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) and one dose of MCV4 (Meningococcal.) Most children will receive these vaccines around 11-13 years of age. Schools must receive the most updated vaccine record that includes the 7th grade requirement of booster Tdap and MCV4 as described above. Parents will need to contact their doctor's office to request an updated vaccine record to submit to school. Please call your doctor's office soon to verify that your child has received these booster vaccines. If they have not, please make an appointment

In an effort to provide a safe and friendly atmosphere, the Athletic Department at Colerain High School is announcing the procedures for Friday night football games.

The following procedures will be implemented:

- All students are required to show a student ID with the purchase of each ticket when entering through the stadium gates.
- There will be a separate line for students at each gate where members of the Colerain Administration Team will confirm the student as either a Colerain student or as a visiting team student.
- All middle school students will be required to enter with an adult through the parent line. Middle school students not accompanied by an adult will not be permitted into the stadium.
- Students not enrolled at either Colerain or the visiting team will not be permitted without an adult.
