### **NEWS FROM THE NURSE:**

### **Incoming 7th Grade Parents**

The Ohio Law requires that before entering 7th grade, students must receive the following vaccines: one dose of Tdap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) and one dose of MCV4 (Meningococcal.) Most children will receive these vaccines around 11-13 years of age. Schools must receive the most updated vaccine record that includes the 7th grade requirement of booster Tdap and MCV4 as described above. Parents will need to contact their doctor's office to request an updated vaccine record to submit to school. Please call your doctor's office soon to verify that your child has received these booster vaccines. If they have not, please make an appointment for your child to receive these vaccines before the start of next school year. Records can be submitted to school via your child, email or mail. You may also ask the doctor if they can fax the updated record to the school at 964-0284.
