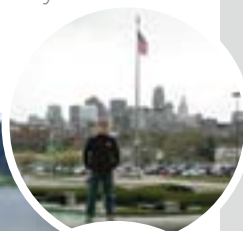
the exchange

time commitments

Full participation during both Cincinnati and Munich experiences, as well as:

- Itinerary planning prior to Munich teachers' visit
- Preparation of a short presentation regarding your school and role
- Reflection sessions after hosting and travelling

requirements

- Active educator in a public school district in Hamilton County
- Able to host and travel during specified dates

finances

HCESC provides a \$1000 scholarship applied to the cost of round trip airfare. Participants are responsible for costs in excess of that amount.

Cincinnati participants are responsible for all costs during the exchange, including meals, tickets, transportation, etc. for themselves and their partners. Partner teachers will reciprocate when in Munich.
