LIBRARY/DEBIT CARDS

Library cards are free to all Ohio residents. Cards are also free to residents of Boone, Campbell, and Kenton Counties in Kentucky with a valid library card from their local library, picture ID, and address verification. You can apply online for a library card at www.CincinnatiLibrary.org.

RETURNS AND RENEWALS

Items may be returned to any location. All items may be renewed in person, at www. CincinnatiLibrary.org, or by calling 513-369-6900. Materials are subject to varying renewal limits.

HOLDS

A library cardholder may place a hold on currently unavailable items. Holds may not be placed on new release feature film DVDs or reference materials. A maximum of 50 items may be placed on hold. Once the hold request is filled, items will be held at branches for 5 days before returning to circulation.

Sundays and closed holidays are included in the fine calculations. When unpaid fines and charges on overdue materials reach \$10, no additional items may be checked out. Charges for damaged materials will be assessed on an individual basis. Lost materials must be paid for in full.

EDUCATION & HOMEWORK SUPPORT

The Library offers online and in-person homework assistance at a number of locations, GED practice testing, provides space for volunteer tutors, adult new reader materials, Shared Reading programs, instructional CD-ROMs, GED study guides, contact lists for literacy programs, test proctoring, suggested books appropriate for various reading levels, and English as a second language conversation groups.

MEETING ROOMS

Meeting rooms are available at many locations for use by groups and individuals who meet the guidelines. Rooms may be reserved in advance by completing the request form at www. Cincinnatilibrary.org.
