OAK HILLS LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT HEALTH SERVICES NOTIFICATION AND INFORMATION ABOUT BED BUGS

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We recently found a bed bug in our building this week. FORTUNATELY, SCHOOLS ARE NOT a favorite home for bed bugs because they do not have a host to feed on at night and they hate bright lights during the day. So if a bed bug comes in with a student, it is not likely to travel very far within the classroom or school.

Bed bugs are a nuisance, but their bites are not known to spread disease. Bed bugs are usually active at night and feed on human blood. The bite does not hurt at first, but it may become swollen and itchy, much like a mosquito bite. Watch for clusters of bites, usually in a line, on exposed areas of the body. If you have concerns for you or your child, please contact your doctor.

The source of bed bugs often cannot be determined, as bed bugs may be found in many places including hotels, planes, and movie theaters. Even though it is unlikely for bed bugs to be spread in schools, OHLSD will conduct an inspection and, if needed, will treat the area where the bed bug was found. We ask that you inspect your home and your child's belongings. Please contact the school nurse or principal if you know you have bed bugs in your home so we can make every effort at school to prohibit it from spreading.

OHLSD will continue to work to identify bed bugs, provide thorough inspections of schools, and have licensed pest control specialists treat the rooms if a problem is found. Contact your physician or school nurse for proper care and treatment of bed bug bites.

If you have any questions regarding bed bugs in your school, please contact the principal or school nurse. If you have any questions regarding bed bugs found in your home, search the <u>Central Ohio Bed Bug Task Force</u> or the <u>Hamilton</u> <u>County Health Department</u>. Most licensed pest control companies in our area will do an inspection at no cost and give advice for treatment.
