Social Media and Its Impact on Bullying

Presented by Council On Child Abuse

Thursday, October 25 6:30pm-8:00pm Rapid Run Auditorium

This workshop will educate parents on smartphone/social media apps and what bullying looks like on those apps!

This year Rapid Run is partnering with the Council on Child Abuse to bring awareness to bullying and social media. The training – Social Media and its Impact on Bullying – will be on Thursday, October 25th and 6:30 PM in the Rapid Run auditorium. All parents and students are welcome to attend. The presentation will review the types of bullying, the difference between mean behavior and bullying, and focus on how social media has changed the way bullying takes place. The training will focus on educating parents on apps, specifically what Snapchat and Instagram are, how to understand the safety and privacy features on these apps, and what bullying looks like on these apps. Parents should walk away feeling more comfortable talking to their kids about what is happening on social media, understanding what their kids are going through, and knowing ways to protect them from bullying and how to report it. No RSVP required, we hope to see you all there!

In observance of National Fire Prevention Month, the Delhi Township Fire Department will host its annual open house on Sunday, October 21, 2018 from 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. at the Neeb Road Fire Station, 697 Neeb Road.

In addition to providing the highest level of fire and emergency medical emergency response to the community, the Fire Department offers a wide range of programs and services that focus on fire and safety education. Residents are invited to stop by the station for a fun, informative visit with fire personnel. In addition to blood pressure checks and guided tours of the station and equipment, there will be hands-on activities to promote fire and safety awareness, including:

- The University Hospital Air Care will land at Our Lady of Victory on the north sports fields (behind church) at 1:00 P.M. Once the aircraft lands, feel free to get an up close look and meet the flight crew! Arrive early to see it land!
- Stop by for an opportunity to learn about the Department's history while viewing the many artifacts on display, including the original fire pumper!
- Kid's Firefighter Challenge Course, for children of all ages who want to suit up and test their firefighter skills and agility (gear only available for kids up to 12 years old).
- The Fire Safety House which teaches life-saving practices on how to safely exit a smoke filled building.
- We will have vintage fire apparatus from the Miles Greenwood Society on display.
- Delhi Township Police Officer Jeff Miller his canine Levi and Fire Investigator Steve Claytor his
 canine Rudy will be there for demonstrations.
- Hamburgers, hot dogs and light refreshments will be provided while supplies last.


