Keeping kids safe at school with food.

Please be mindful when sending in treats to school to share with your child's friends.



We ask that all foods are **preferably packaged with the label** that can provide ingredients (for food allergies) and Carbohydrate counts (for diabetic insulin dosing and student with other medical conditions that are diet control related)

Food Allergy?

- A food allergy is a medical condition in which exposure to a food triggers a harmful immune response. The immune response, called an allergic reaction, occurs because the immune system attacks proteins in the food that are normally harmless. The proteins that trigger the reaction are called allergens.
- The symptoms of an allergic reaction to food can range from mild (itchy mouth, a few hives) to severe (throat tightening, difficulty breathing).
- Anaphylaxis is a serious allergic reaction that is sudden in onset and can cause death.

Milk, eggs, peanuts, tree nuts, soy, wheat, fish, shellfish and sesame are the most common food allergens.

Carbohydrate counts

- allow the nurse to properly calculate the insulin dose for a diabetic student and this allows them to have the treat as well.
- Some seizure conditions are controlled by a balance of macronutrients (e.g., fat, protein, carbohydrate).
