

Good Afternoon,

This is a piggyback to my information last week on the Pertussis topic.

This past week, we have had positive cases of Pertussis in the District. It is on the rise in our county- We are in daily conversations with our liaison with Hamilton County Board of Health.

Questions that have been asked:

Are all of OHLSD student immunized?

Students are required by the state and OHLSD to be vaccinated but some can choose an exemption for medical, religious and good cause. A form has be filled out and if good cause we call and ask for a yearly update of the exemption.

The good cause is the hard one, and the nurses at OHLSD work hard on helping decrease those numbers, to make sure it is not an easy out. We help give resources of locations if there are financial barriers.

Facts:

OHLSD schools only have a few exemptions per school.

All students to date with Pertussis, have been vaccinated. (weaker case because of it but still sick)

Hamilton County has an outbreak countywide and the Adult population is a large place the students can be at risk. The cough and symptoms are mimicking other illnesses and even doctors are not diagnosing it right away (this will change now because of the alert) and some will not even be tested - just given the antibiotic in case.

What are we doing:

Cleaning cleaning!

We are being proactive. One place is in the classrooms where students are sharing items. Ex: art room, music, gym and Kg classrooms (shared pencils and markers)

Cleaning the handrails, drinking fountains, desks, pencil sharpeners more often. As the custodial staff always does as flu season starts!

All rooms of positive cases cleaned - custodial team notified immediately. (they get a note of that child's day schedule) Things we are going over with the kids: (please talk with them)

- 1. It is flu season and whooping cough can mimic it too but usually the cough is more intense and lasts longer.
- 2. wash hands!!!!! Great Hand Washing Video to get the point across!!
- 3. cover your cough! Covering coughs and how far germs can gohttps://www.youtube.com/watch?v=lghy7w49vTU
- 4. do not share drinks and food
- 5. clean chromebooks and phones
- 6. no hugging/kissing (some of our students are dating)
- 7. Overall good hygiene and diet
