## **Bed Bugs in the Community**

## A Growing Problem

As you may know, bed bugs have made their presence known in Southwest Ohio. Public health research shows that bed bugs do not spread disease. Oak Hills Local School District does, however, understand the importance of preventing and controlling bed bugs. Bed bugs are a public health nuisance and often create fear and anxiety among our families.

## How do you help prevent bed bugs from infesting your home?

Start a family routine to check clothing, shoes, purse/backpacks, and books on a daily basis to prevent a "hitchhiker" from coming home with you. Bed bugs like dark places, they are nocturnal blood feeders and are most likely to come in contact with you when traveling, spending the night in an infested location such as a hotel, hospital, or home of someone with an infestation.

**FORTUNATELY, SCHOOLS ARE NOT** a favorite home for bed bugs because they do not have a host to feed on at night and they hate bright lights during the day. So if a bed bug comes in with a student, it is not likely to travel very far within the classroom or school.

The school district has guidelines from the Hamilton County Health Department in place when bed bugs are found at school or on a student. If we find a bug on your student we will call you and give further instructions. If you have an occurrence of bed bugs at your home, please call school to report it to your school nurse. By being forthcoming with this information, we can help you with the most current information and eliminate the spread of bed bugs among our families in the district.

## If bed bugs are suspected in the home:

- 1. Look for:
  - Small rusty spots on mattress and/or bed linens
  - Small blood smears on bedding from crushed insects
  - Dried remains of shed bed bug skin
  - Irritated, inflamed, itchy welts on your skin, usually in rows of three

\*Bites alone do NOT indicate bed bug infestation. Other insects leave similar bites. Live bed bugs must be present for positive infestation.

- 2. Thoroughly inspect in, under, and around:
  - Mattress and Box spring
  - Bed frame
  - Furniture
  - Switch Plates
  - Small cracks in furniture, floor, or walls
  - Carpet
  - Baseboards, Window and Door frames
- 3. If living in apartment or multi-family homes:
  - Advise landlord
  - Instruct neighbors in adjoining units to inspect home
- 4. Once location of bugs is known:

- Save a sample of the bed bugs in zip-lock bag to be correctly identified
- Call professional exterminator- most will give a free inspection and advice.
- Vacuum affected area
- Dispose vacuumed contents in sealed plastic bag and immediately place outside
- Remove infested clothing and bedding, wash in hot water (102°) and dry on high heat for at least 30 minutes
- Cover mattress and box spring with a zippered mattress cover (keep on for 1 year)
- 5. If bugs found on body:
  - Remove bugs by use of tweezers, gloves, paper towel, etc.
  - Put bugs in zip-locked bag and place outside in garbage can
  - Wash clothing or personal items in hot water (102°) and dry on high heat for at least 30 minutes
  - Treat bites with antihistamine (Cortisone) cream
  - Avoid itching bites to prevent infection
- 6. Bed bug infestation is NOT usually associated with poor hygiene or bad housekeeping
  - Inform school administrator of bed bug findings
  - Student should NOT be excluded from school due to bedbugs
  - Inspect items before leaving house
  - Send only essential items to school with student and keep these items in a XL ziploc bag to ensure items are bed bug free.

To protect your child from embarrassment during an infestation keep clean school clothes in a sealed bin or bag to ensure that what they put on in the morning is bed bug free. Never have the student keep clothes, shoes and backpack for school near their bed during an infestation.
