Dear Rapid Run Parents,

In the coming weeks your child will take the Ohio AIR Assessments in English Language Arts, Math, and 8th Grade Science.

The results of this assessment give us an accurate picture of whether students are on track to be ready for college or a career according to the criteria in Ohio's Learning Standards. Our school receives the results in the summer and uses these results to reflect on how we are meeting individual student needs with our curriculum, instruction, and assessment.

This assessment will take place in the morning on the test dates listed below. We ask for your help in preparing your student in the following ways, so we gain the most accurate picture of their progress possible:

- Ensure your child is on time to school on these days. Tests begin after students have had time to get organized. Tardy students will either have to scramble to get ready or take the test another day.
- Encourage your child to get a good night's sleep. Energy and attentiveness ensure that students can show what they truly know on the assessment.
- Eating a healthy breakfast. This also helps students have the energy they will need to be attentive during the test.
- Hydrated. Proper hydration is essential to good health, and water bottles will be permitted in the test environment.
- Ensure your child's Chromebook is charged the night before the assessment (if your child takes them home). The AIR assessment is administered through their Chromebooks, and changing computers or looking for a charger can disrupt their testing progress.

5/6 & 5/7 - Math

7th Grade

4/9 & 4/10 - English Language

Arts

4/30 & 5/1 - Math

8th Grade

4/15 & 4/16 - English Language

Arts

4/25 - Science

5/2 & 5/3 - Math
