Dear Rapid Run Parents,

In the coming weeks your child will take the Ohio AIR Assessments in English Language Arts, Math, and 8th Grade Science.

The results of this assessment give us an accurate picture of whether students are on track to be ready for college or a career according the criteria in Ohio's Learning Standards. Our school receives the results in the summer and uses these results to reflect on how we are meeting individual student needs with our curriculum, instruction, and assessment.

This assessment will take place in the morning on the test dates listed below. We ask for your help in preparing your student in the following ways, so we gain the most accurate picture of their progress possible:

- Ensure your child is on time to school on these days. Tests begin after students have had time to get
 organized. Tardy students will either have to scramble to get ready or take the test another day.
- Encourage your child to get a good night's sleep. Energy and attentiveness ensure that students can show what they truly know on the assessment.
- <u>Eating a healthy breakfast</u>. This also helps students have the energy they will need to be attentive during the test.
- <u>Hydrated</u>. Proper hydration is essential to good health, and water bottles will be permitted in the test environment.
- Ensure your child's Chromebook is charged the night before the assessment (if your child takes them
 home). The AIR assessment is administered through their Chromebooks, and changing computers or
 looking for a charger can disrupt their testing progress.

The Sustainability Committee of Mount St. Joseph University and the Oak Hills School District are proud to sponsor a COMMUNITY ELECTRONICS RECYCLING DAY on Saturday, April 6th, 2019 from 10 AM - 2 PM in the student parking lot (north lot) of Oak Hills High School. There are no residency requirements to drop off items and ANY item with an electrical cord will be accepted. This includes all TVs (any size), refrigerators and all other household appliances (microwaves, washers, vacuum cleaners, etc.), cell phones, game systems, iPods, Blackberries, MP3 players, digital cameras, GPS units, e-readers, all computers and related accessories (such as keyboards, printers, portable hard drives, and scanners), VCR/DVD/CD players, fax machines, copiers, surge protectors, power cables and charging cords, electronic wiring, and satellite components.

A \$15 donation is requested for each small cathode ray tube (CRT) TV/monitor dropped off and a \$25 donation is requested for each large TV (consoles, large flat screens, and rear projection TVs). For those without TVs to drop off, a \$10 donation is requested per vehicle. These donations help to defray both disposal fees for the hazardous waste components of the items to be recycled and transportation costs.

RecycleForce, a non-profit from Indianapolis, will de-manufacture these items and shred all hard drives to address any privacy concerns. The plastics and metals are then collected, packaged, and sold to build new components, while all toxic elements, such as lead and mercury, will be disposed of properly to avoid environmental contamination. RecycleForce provides transitional jobs to formerly incarcerated people, helping them to rebuild their lives and increase their chances of sustained future employment.
